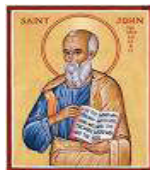

This commitment includes: Providing children opportunities to have a voice (speak out and be heard); Protecting children from harm; Ensuring children's basic needs are met.



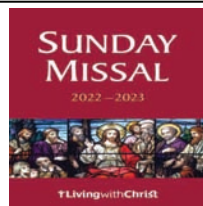
