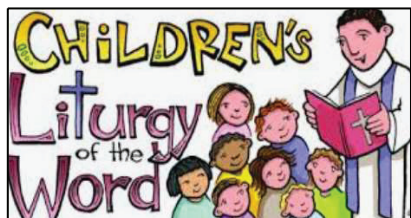
The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory.

Children's Liturgy is offered during Sunday Mass at St. John's

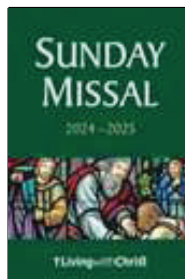
Children's School Mass : New Date!
