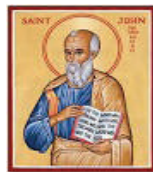

Bless those who came home broken in body and spirit as well as the families of our troops, and fill their homes and their lives with Your strength and peace.

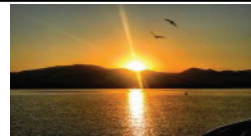

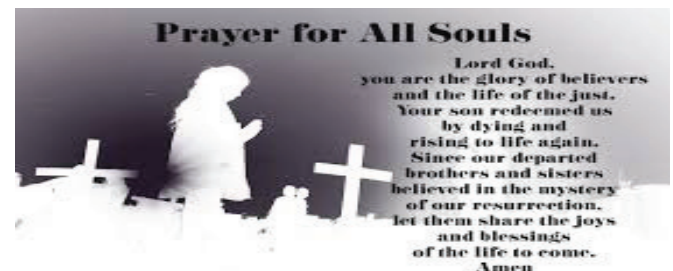
