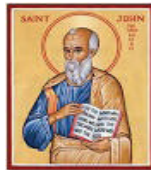

Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day

is an annual day of remembrance observed on October 15 for pregnancy loss and infant death, which includes miscarriage, stillbirth, SIDS, and the death of a newborn.

Pregnancy and infant loss is a common experience that has historically been complicated by broadly applied social and cultural taboos to stay silent, a condition that the World Health Organization advocates reversing in favour of open expression. The Wave of Light, founded in 2003 invites baby loss families, friends, loved ones and supporting organizations from around the world to join in honour and remembrance on October 15 by lighting a candle at 7:00 pm for one hour in all time zones.
