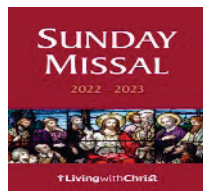

First Sunday in Advent is November 27. In preparation for the new Season, Sunday Missals for 2022-2023 will be available for \$5.00 the week of October 29-30.



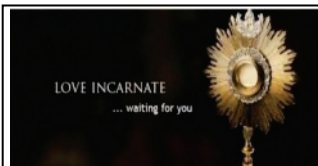
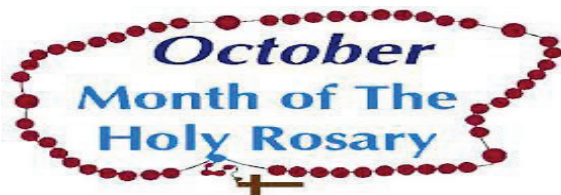
We will be starting to take up the collection in the church the weekend of October 29-30.
