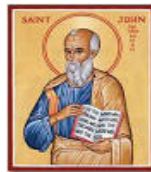

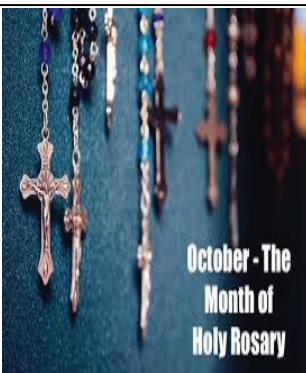

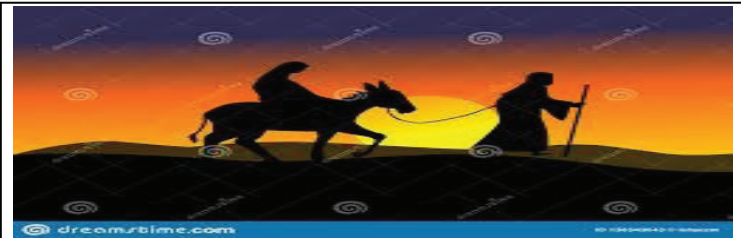
***CCCB National Liturgy Webinar,

Daily sessions will be led by award-winning author, Father Gilbert Ostdiek, O.F.M..

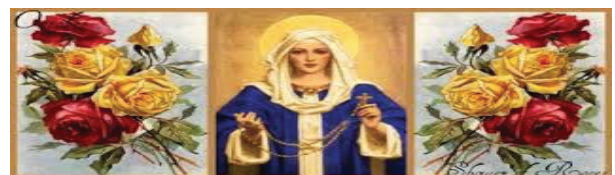
