Ordinary Time**

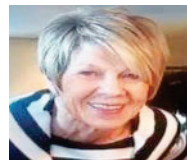
First Reading: Isaiah 25.6-10a

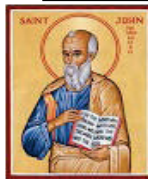
