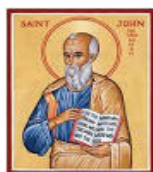

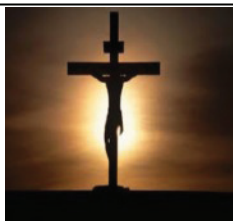

Votive Candles will increase to \$1.00 each this will also help to defray the cost of ordering them by the case and delivery

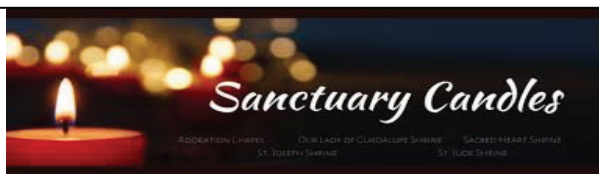
