Give a gift of a Mass for someone's Birthday, to someone who is ill or undergoing surgery. Envelopes at back.

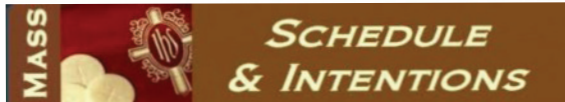

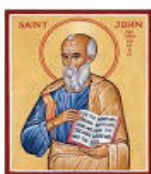
