## SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY:

August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On this day the Church celebrates our Lord's victory over death as it is embodied in His Blessed Mother. The

Feast of the Assumption acknowledges that Mary shares in the power of our Lord's Resurrection as she is assumed body and soul into heaven. Join us for Mass at 7pm on Tuesday, August 15th.



**CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES:** Repairs are ongoing with the tower and steeple of the church. The large windows in the front of the tower are in poorer shape than expected and will have to be replaced. As well, the steeple cross

which is crooked at the moment will also need work. The contractor is working at getting a metal worker to examine what can be done. Unfortunately, those who are qualified to deal with the copper roof and cross are few and far between. In the meantime, as long as the lift is still parked in the lower parking lot we will keep the chapel closed. We cannot give an exact time-frame for reopening.
