
#### **CHRISTMAS FLORAL TRIBUTES:**

All are invited to bring your Baby Jesus figurines from your homes to Mass on December 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> at all Masses to be blessed as we too celebrate our own Bambinelli Sunday. After the blessing you are encouraged to take your 'Bambinelli' home and place it in a gift box, wrap the box and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift you open on Christmas day and as you lay Jesus in the Manger, allow this moment to be a reminder of the great blessings we receive at Christmas.
