with New Year's falling on a Monday the vigil mass will be celebrated on Sunday evening. The morning Masses on Sunday are for the *Feast of the Holy Family*. The New Year's Mass schedule is December 31st at 5:00 p.m. and New Year's Day at 11:00 a.m.
