February 23, 2023 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM for a film screening featuring two short films that highlight challenges and approaches to affordable housing. A **Better Tent City** follows a group of dedicated individuals, including those living rough, service providers, community members and municipal staff, working together to create a self-organized housing community in Kitchener, ON. Safe explores the housing and opioid crises through the stories of tenants that live in Indwell affordable housing units, available for people experiencing poverty because of their mental health and/or substance use disorders, in Hamilton, London, Woodstock, Simcoe and Mississauga.
