FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD: On February 2nd, 40 days after Christmas, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation, which commemorates Mary and Joseph bringing Jesus to the Jerusalem Temple so as to

present him to the Lord. Acknowledging that Jesus is the Light of the Nations is one of the themes of this feast day and so it is customary to bless candles at Mass on this day. At the 8:00 am Mass on Friday, February 2nd, candles will be blessed and will be available for an offering of \$5. You can bring your own candles that day and they can also be blessed as part of the liturgy.
