WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE **SANCTIFICATION OF PRIESTS: JUNE 16**

This day was begun by Saint John Paul II in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of Priests. The World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests coincides with the Feast of the Most Sacred **Heart of Jesus.** The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has a long history but it became more widespread in the Church after the personal revelation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alocoque in the 17th century. Jesus commissioned her with the work of spreading this devotion. The devotion of the Sacred Heart reminds us that the heart of Jesus was pierced for us. Our Lord suffered for love of us. This devotion is intimately linked to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Divine Mercy and above all, the Eucharist - the Sacrament of Jesus' Body and Blood.
