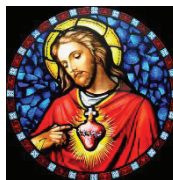


FAMILY ROSARY NIGHT: You and your family are invited to join us for a Family Rosary Night on **Wed., January 28th at 6:30 p.m.** in the
