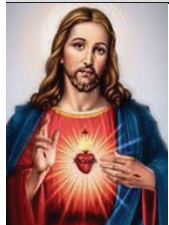

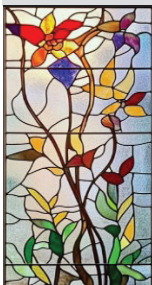

We hope you can join us for this special Celebration!



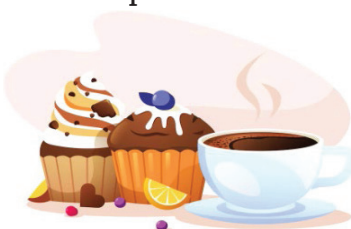
Coffee Sunday Sunday, June 29th, 2025
