### **Eucharist & Communion**

"In Abitene, a small village in present-day Tunisia, fortynine Christians were taken by surprise one Sunday while they were celebrating the Eucharist, thereby defying the imperial prohibitions. They were arrested and taken to Carthage to be interrogated. Significant is the answer a certain Emeritus gave to the proconsul who asked him why on earth they had disobeyed the emperor's severe orders. He replied: We cannot live without joining together on Sunday to celebrate the Eucharist. We would lack the strength to face our daily problems. Christ is truly present among us in the Eucharist. It is a dynamic presence that grasps us, to make us his own, to make us assimilate him. Christ draws us to him, he makes us come out of ourselves to make us all one with him...Communion with the Lord is always also communion with our brothers and sisters." Excerpt from Benedictus.
