Good Friday Collection for the benefit of the Holy Land

The Pontifical Collection for the benefit of the Holy Land is held this year on Good Friday, April 2.

Each year on Good Friday, our parish is called to support Christians in the Holy Land. Many Christians in the Holy Land depend on the collection for their lives.

As a Pontifical collection requested by Pope Francis, the annual Good Friday Collection helps to maintain not only the Holy Places above all, but also the pastoral, welfare, educational and social works that the Church carries out to the benefit of Christians and the local population.

Reminder: There will also be a collection on Holy Thursday for the benefit of the poor which may go to refugee sponsorship.

Easter Obligation (Duty)

The Easter obligation is the grave duty that every Catholic has to receive Holy Communion during the Easter season, which concludes on the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord.

The Eucharist is the sacrament that preserves the soul's union with God and fosters that union by making a person more holy. A person must be in a state of God's friendship (grace) when receiving, otherwise the reception becomes a sacrilege.

In the sacrament of the most Holy Eucharist is contained truly, really, and substantially the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, it is the necessary condition of the soul to be free of mortal sin and pleasing to God before reception of Holy Communion. If a soul is not in this state, they should refrain from receiving Holy Communion and perhaps just receive a blessing instead until they have gone to Confession.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS **FOR PALM SUNDAY**



As we enter Holv Week we are faced with the great paradox of the cross. The crucifixion

from a mere human standpoint was an utter and humiliating defeat for Jesus. How could God let Himself be killed by His own creatures? The only way we can recognize the sublime beauty and victory of the cross is if we view it through a Divine lens. The Jews resisted accepting the necessity of the crucifixion because they expected Him to be a wondrous king that would set them free from the political rule of the Romans. Jesus on the other hand comes as a poor and lowly carpenter sent to set them free not from political tyranny, but from the tyranny of sin. To do this, he "humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death – even death on a cross" (Philippians 2:8). Jesus hid all of His Divine majesty with His humanity and allowed Himself to die for love of us. It was because of this humility that "God highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name" (Philippians 2:9). As stewards, we may sometimes forget the truth found in the paradox of the cross. It is not our own strength or achievements that make us great but it is rather our humility and obedience to God. The Lord can bring about tremendous good out of our willingness to humbly serve Him wherever He places us. As we enter Holy Week, let us take some time to meditate on the radical humility of Christ crucified and seek to imitate Him in our own lives as stewards.
