Immersion in Living Water
EZEKIEL 47 8, 12

Call to Action: Our Father calls us to accept His love (1 John 4:19). Welcoming that love as daughters and sons, through a continual conversion of mind and heart, is our lifelong calling. If we step into the true living water, we can contribute to a more just and life-giving world for the entire human family as well as for non-human creation



Psalms: The School of Prayer is a ten-session study that explores how the Psalms teach us to pray and respond to God with faith and trust.

At the heart of Scripture

are the Psalms, prayers inspired by the Holy Spirit, sung by Israel, and prayed by Christ and our Blessed Mother. These sacred hymns invite us into a personal dialogue with God. In this study, you will explore the Psalms and discover how these ancient prayers express every human emotion while pointing to the life and mission of Jesus. Guided by Jeff Cavins, Dr. Tim Gray, and Sarah Christmyer, this study helps you meditate on Scripture, pray using *lectio divina*, and develop a deeper life of prayer. ***10 Sessions 50-Minute Videos***
