

Who may receive communion

We welcome visitors to our parish, Catholic and non-Catholic. We receive many enquiries as to who may receive communion at a Roman Catholic Mass. We hope the following helps to clarify:

- a) Non-Roman Catholics, even though they receive in their own denomination, <u>may not</u> receive communion in the Roman Catholic tradition, since for us the reception of Eucharist includes an assertion that the recipient accepts the fullness of the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, including the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, the primacy of the Holy Father in matters of faith and morals, the total rejection of abortion, and so on. Non-Roman Catholics are welcome to receive a blessing (signify this by crossing the arms over the chest). Non-Roman Catholics interested in becoming Roman Catholic should contact our parish office.
- b) Roman Catholics who are <u>not</u> married according to the practice of the Roman Catholic Church (i.e. within a Roman Catholic ceremony, or, if outside, with the proper dispensation before the wedding, or with convalidation following the wedding) may not receive the Eucharist until their situation has been regularized (contact the Parish office), but may receive a blessing (see above).
- c) Roman Catholics who do not attend Roman Catholic Mass weekly, except when it is because of medical reasons, must receive the sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) before receiving the Eucharist. They are always welcome to receive a blessing.

Since the Eucharist is the Asource and summit of our Catholic faith @, we appreciate the appropriate respect shown to the Eucharist and its reception
