Daylight Savings Time is Sunday March 9<sup>th</sup> – a reminder to keep our families safe by changing the batteries in our smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. **BATTERIES** contain toxic metals such as lithium, cadmium, nickel, lead and mercury. When dumped in landfills they can burst, poisoning soil and ground water and damaging or killing surrounding plant life. At times the heavy metals end up in the drinking water supply. Animals often mistake them for food, and die when the batteries burst in their stomachs. Please help care for God's creation and bring all of your dead batteries to church during the two weekends of March 8/9<sup>th</sup> and March 15/16<sup>th</sup> and drop them in the GREEN bins at all the entrances. 
