

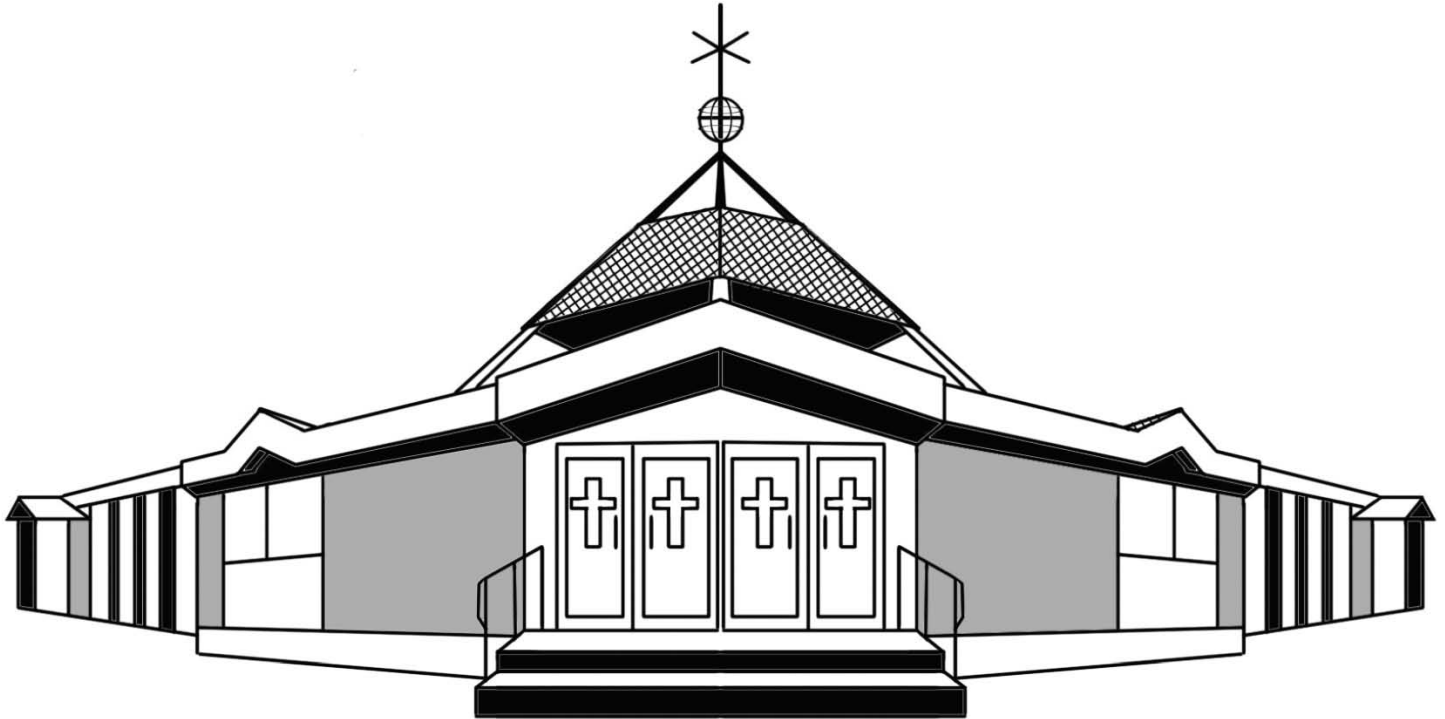

SACRISTY RENOVATION PROJECT

We are pleased to announce that we will be renovating the sacristy in the coming months. If you've been in the sacristy recently, you'll have noticed that the cupboards and drawers are in a dilapidated state and some do not open or close properly. Also, the counter with the sink has a large rotted area from various faucet leaks over the years. A little over a year ago, a family member of mine died and bequeathed to the parish \$25,000. I decided to use that as seed money for the renovation project. In addition, we have also recently been awarded a \$40,00 grant from the diocesan Ex Corde Foundation to be put toward this project. The sum of \$65,000 will cover the cost of the renovation which will be \$61,500 (\$17,500 to replace the sacristy windows and \$44,000 for the new cabinets and counters) plus various ancillary costs (e.g., paint, supplies, etc). On behalf of the parish, I wish to express our deep gratitude to my departed loved one for the bequest and to the Ex Corde Foundation for awarding us the generous grant. I also wish to thank all who have assisted in coordinating this project — our finance committee, Michael Pollard, Dick and Mary De Jong, and so many others.
