

GOOD NEWS ABOUT TOXINS!

In 2009 the Canadian Medical Association called for a ban on the household use of triclosan citing concerns that the chemical may be contributing to the spread of antibiotic resistant bacteria ("superbugs"). The good news is that recently Proctor & Gamble announced it will discontinue the use of controversial chemicals phalates, and triclosan from all its products by 2014. Research shows that wastewater treatment plants are unable to filter the chemical out of the water. Phthalates are often found in cosmetics & fragrances & are endocrine disruptors. Their use has been linked to everything from lower sperm counts and low testosterone in men. autism. breast cancer and testicular cancer. Walmart U.S. also committed to reducing or eliminating 10 chemicals in the products it sells and for its suppliers to disclose the ingredients in their products. Suppliers will be required to provide online public ingredient disclosure by January 2015. Companies are listening and both of these announcements happened because of the efforts of people like you. We have the right to know what's in the products we buy, so we can make informed purchasing decisions and reduce our exposure to toxic chemicals. For more petitions and information go to:
