Parenting Tip of the Month: As the leaves change
and the weather turns colder (and often wetter!), we
tend to spend more time indoors. This is a perfect
season for quality family time. Instead of everyone
being on social media and playing online games, try
an old-fashioned board game, working together to
put a puzzle together, having a family book club, or
watching a movie on TV together and pausing now
and then to discuss what is going on and/or what
might happen next. Interaction is the key and when
we do so we build bonds and relationships. Children
talk to us and tell us things when they are ready, so
the more time we spend together, the greater the
