



(From a parishioner) How often should I go to confession?

I listened to a talk recently where a priest addressed this question. In my opinion, his analogy made sense.

First the priest asked how often people took showers or washed their clothes? Once a year? Perhaps once or twice per month? Or perhaps once per week? I, along with the other people in the audience, laughed at how silly all these options sounded. Then he said, if you are ones who wash once per year or even once per month – imagine how that would smell.

Now, instead of washing externally, think about yourself internally. If you only go to confession once per year or whenever you feel like it, how do you think your soul would "smell"?

Silence in the room! We weren't laughing anymore. With love in his eyes, the priest explained, **Confession**, through your priest, is where God absolves you of your sins and cleans your soul.
