Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. This day invites us to reflect on our own hearts—do we welcome Jesus only when it's easy and joyful, or do we remain faithful even when the path leads to the cross? Palm Sunday calls us to humility, to follow Jesus not just in triumph, but also in surrender, trusting that through the cross comes resurrection and new life.

Please plan to avail yourself of the Sacrament of Reconciliation during a scheduled time as the priests may be to busy during Holy Week to accommodate appointments for confessions.

What do I do with my old Palms?

Next Sunday we commemorate Palm Sunday. We're often asked what to do with our old blessed palm branches? Because they have been blessed we should not just throw them out. Here are your options:

- 1.) Keep them as decorations, perhaps placed behind a religious picture or Crucifix
- 2.) Burn them, and spread the ashes in your garden
- 3.) Bury the palms in your garden
- 4.) Although we would prefer if you dispose of them yourselves, if you have no means to do so, you may return them to the parish to be burned for use on Ash Wednesday next year.

These methods of disposal honour the palm's sacred purpose and returns them to the earth in a dignified way.
