Reduce Food Waste - Best Before & Expiration Dates

Check it out before you chuck it out. Don't throw out food just because it's past the best before date! Best before dates and expiration dates are not the same. Expiration dates relate to food safety and are only on certain foods with strict nutritional and compositional specifications (such as infant formula or meal replacements). The items should be disposed of once the expiry date has passed. Best before dates refer to freshness and quality, not safety. They indicate when a product will be at its tastiest and freshest. After that date, the food may still be safe to eat, it just might not be at peak quality. How date labels help reduce food waste and save money. More foods include best before dates than required by law. Why? They help you check it out before you chuck it out; they help you know how long items have been in your fridge or pantry; they give you a reference point so you can choose which foods to use first; they can save you money, as stores often discount items approaching their best before dates; they help industry monitor production and manage stock rotation.
