In today's gospel, Jesus offers a radical redefinition of what it means to be blessed. He lifts up the poor, the hungry, the weeping, and the persecuted, promising them joy and fulfillment in God's kingdom. At the same time, He warns the rich, the satisfied, and those who seek worldly praise that their comfort is fleeting and spiritually dangerous. This passage challenges our modern values, which often equate success with wealth, comfort, and popularity. Jesus invites us to see life through a kingdom lens, where dependence on God, compassion for others, and faithfulness in adversity are true measures of blessing. Reflecting on this, we are called to examine where we seek fulfillment. Do we chase temporary pleasures and human approval, or do we trust God's promise to fill us with lasting joy? Jesus' words remind us that living for His kingdom may come with hardship, but it brings a deeper, eternal reward. May we find courage to embrace that path and compassion to stand in solidarity with those whom Jesus calls blessed.

#### **Her Heart Matters Awareness**

According to the Canadian Women's Heart Health Centre, heart disease used to be considered a "man's disease", but no longer. While heart disease is on the decline among men, it is rising among women, it is the number one killer of women worldwide, and the leading cause of premature death in women in Canada. Much of what we know about the diagnosis and treatment of heart disease is based on research in men, but women's hearts and the way they experience heart disease are different in many ways. Women generally have higher heart rates and smaller hearts and arteries than men. While male hormones enlarge arteries, female hormones make them smaller, making women's arteries more prone to blood clots or blockages and more difficult to repair. Globally, cardiovascular diseases affect 1 out of 3 women, yet women everywhere are under-studied, under-diagnosed, undertreated, and under-aware. 80% of a woman's risk factors are within her control, and heart disease is largely preventable.
