Today's gospel tells the story of Jesus calling His first disciples, specifically Simon Peter, James, and John. After a miraculous catch of fish, Simon Peter falls at Jesus' feet, overwhelmed by awe and humility, declaring himself a sinful man. Jesus responds by reassuring him and calling him to a greater mission — to become a "fisher of people." What stands out most for me is Jesus' response to Simon's sense of sinfulness and unworthiness. God doesn't call the perfect; He transforms and commissions the willing. This passage invites us to recognize God's ability to do the extraordinary through ordinary lives when we say "yes" to His call.
