Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Psoriasis Awareness

According to the Canadian Association of Psoriasis Patients, psoriasis is a persistent chronic inflammatory condition that affects approximately 1 million Canadians. Psoriasis severity ranges from a few dandruff-like scales to widespread patches covering large skin areas. Psoriasis may flare up and then go into remission. During flare-ups, psoriasis causes itchiness and pain in the inflamed skin. In psoriasis, overactive signals in the body's immune system trigger new skin cells to grow too quickly, and the cells pile up on the skin surface creating painful and itchy red lesions called plaques. Psoriasis is not contagious and cannot be spread from one person to another. Visit www.canadianpsoriasis.ca for more information.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

There is sometimes confusion over what the Sacrament of the Sick is. Anyone experiencing serious illness may receive the sacrament, not just those who are close to death. In fact, it is preferable to receive the sacrament early in an illness when the person in ill health can benefit from the healing graces available as they battle their sickness. It is also the case that one can receive the Sacrament more than once during a time of serious illness, so there is no need to wait until the 'last minute' to call the priest. 'Last Rites', as the sacrament is often referred to, is actually the receiving of

three sacraments if the person is able – *Reconciliation*, *Anointing of the Sick*, and *Holy Communion*. If you or a loved one have been diagnosed with a serious illness, contact the office to set up a time to receive the sacrament. If it is a hospital emergency (at <u>any</u> hospital, not just Georgetown), the nurses will have the contact information of local on-call priests which you can request.
