Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

In this closing passage of Luke's Gospel that we hear today, Jesus confirms that His suffering, death, and resurrection were part of God's divine plan, fulfilling Scripture. He commissions His disciples to be witnesses of these events and promises them the power of the Holy Spirit. Then, blessing them, He ascends into heaven. This moment is both awe-inspiring and deeply instructive. Jesus departs, not in sorrow, but in blessing, and His followers respond with grief, but with joy and worship. It marks a shift: from Jesus' earthly ministry to the disciples' Spirit-empowered mission. It is a great lesson for us as well that faith is not just about what Christ has done for us — it's about what we are now called to do because of Him. We, too, are witnesses. His blessing is still upon us, and His Spirit still equips us to carry His message to the world with joy, courage, and hope.

Move for Migraine is June 1-8 - Raise Awareness

According to Migraine Canada, participants can show their support by running, walking, bicycling, swimming, practicing yoga, relaxing, etc., to spread awareness and show support. Migraine is not a type of headache – it is a genetic neurological disease. While headache is a common symptom, migraine is a chemical and electrical phenomenon in the brain. It affects 5 million Canadians, including 25% of women, 8% of men, and 10% of children. During a migraine attack, various areas of the brain get activated. People experience sensitivity to light, sounds, smells, and movement, and many also have nausea and vomiting, brain fog, dizziness, and neck pain.
