HEALTH & WELLNESS COMMITTEE

Heart Attack or Panic Attack

According to the Canadian Mental Health Association, up to 1/3 of adults have panic attacks. Tight chest; racing heart; shortness of breath; nausea; light-headedness. These are symptoms of both a heart attack and a panic attack - know the difference. Panic attacks come on suddenly and intensely, often described as a surge of overwhelming anxiety or fear. Though frightening, they are typically short-lived. Common symptoms include a racing heartbeat, sweating, trembling, shortness of breath, chest pain, dizziness and a sense of detachment. Triggers may include stress, anxiety, caffeine, alcohol, or substance use disorders. A heart attack occurs when blood flow to the heart is blocked, causing damage to the heart muscle. The most common cause is coronary artery disease. Typical symptoms include chest tightness or cramplike discomfort, but others might experience indigestion, jaw/back/neck pain, sweating, shortness of breath or nausea. Symptoms may be sudden or develop gradually. Women often have different symptoms than men. Triggers include a sudden increase in the heart's oxygen demand, like during intense exercise, extreme temperatures or strong emotions. If you suspect a heart attack, get immediate medical attention, as early treatment is critical to prevent lasting damage. If panic attacks are frequent, disrupt your life, or feel unmanageable, reach out to a healthcare provider for support.
