*Marriage* - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

*Sacrament of the Sick* - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

#### March 21 is World Down Syndrome Day

The 21st day of March was selected to signify the uniqueness of the triplication of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome. Down syndrome is a naturally occurring chromosomal arrangement that has always existed and is universal across racial, gender, and socio-economic lines. One in every 781 babies born in Canada has Down syndrome. The chance of having a baby with Down syndrome increases with the mother's age; however, about half of babies born with Down syndrome are born to mothers under 35 years old simply because more young women are having babies. People with Down syndrome might look similar and share some common physical features, but most of all, they will look like their family members and will have their unique personalities and talents.
