May is Melanoma and Skin Cancer Awareness Month

The impact of melanoma and skin cancer is more than skin deep. According to Melanoma Canada, melanoma is one of the few cancers on the rise, affecting people regardless of sex, age, or race. Skin cancer is the abnormal growth of skin cells that can develop on skin exposed to the sun or tanning beds. Among the different types, melanoma is the most dangerous and potentially deadly, as it can metastasize (spread) to other parts of the body. Unlike most other cancers, melanoma can be seen on the skin. Checking the skin monthly is key to early detection and improving survival rates. Non-melanoma skin cancer typically grows slowly. If left untreated, it can invade tissues below the skin and spread throughout the body. Most cases of skin cancer are preventable. The key to prevention is minimizing exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation, which comes from the sun and artificial sources such as tanning beds. Taking simple, proactive steps - like applying sunscreen, seeking shade, and avoiding tanning beds – can significantly reduce the risk of developing skin cancer.
