From the Pastor's Desk

In the gospel today Jesus explains to the disciples the deep connection between love and obedience. He promises that those who love Him and keep His word will be embraced by the Father, and that He and the Father will dwell with them. This intimacy speaks to the heart of Christian faith—not just following rules, but living in relationship with God. Jesus also prepares His disciples for His departure, offering them peace—not as the world gives, but a divine peace that calms troubled hearts. The promise of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, is a reassurance that they will not be left alone. The Spirit will teach and remind them of all Jesus has said, continuing His work in their lives. This gospel today is both a comfort and a challenge: to live in faithful love, trust in God's presence even when He seems absent, and to embrace the peace that only Christ can give.

May is Food Allergy Awareness Month

According to Food Allergy Canada, food allergy is one of the leading causes of potentially life-threatening anaphylactic reactions and a public health concern, especially among children. A food allergy occurs when the body's immune system mistakenly identifies a certain food as harmful, triggering an allergic response. Over 3 million Canadians are affected by food allergy; that's 7.5% of the population. The impact of food allergy is far greater, with an estimated 50% of households either directly or indirectly affected. Since there is currently no cure and the severity of an allergic reaction cannot be predicted, strict avoidance of the allergenic food is the only way to prevent a reaction. This year, Food Allergy Canada's campaign "Know it. Treat it." aims to demystify anaphylaxis and empower everyone to "Know" the signs and symptoms of anaphylaxis and how to "Treat It".
