Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. The sessions provide presentations, materials and a sacred space where the children can grow in their personal relationship with God, as it is first proclaimed to them through Jesus, the Good Shepherd. November is Fall Prevention Awareness Month

Together, we can raise awareness about fall prevention and encourage everyone to recognize their role in preventing falls and fall-related injuries across all ages. Falling is a normal part of development as children learn to walk, climb, run, jump, play, and explore their environment. Most childhood falls do not result in serious injury; however, falls are the leading cause of injury-related hospital admissions among children aged 0 to 14. As we age, natural changes in our bodies can affect how we feel, move, and behave. Among older adults, falls are the leading cause of injury-related hospitalizations, with 20-30% of older adults experiencing a fall each year. Strategies to prevent falls in older adults: exercises that challenge balance and build strength, don't rush when walking or getting up, have vision and hearing checked regularly, review your medications regularly with your pharmacist or doctor, wear well-fitting sturdy shoes, use a cane or mobility aid if needed, and keep stairs and walkways clear of clutter.
