September is Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) Awareness Month

FASD is a lifelong disability that affects the brain and body of people who were exposed to alcohol in the womb. Each person with FASD has both strengths and challenges and will need special supports to help them succeed with many different parts of their daily lives. Strengths include being friendly, likeable, affectionate, determined, hard-working, forgiving, non-judgemental, and caring. According to CanFASD, 90% of individuals with FASD also experience mental health issues. Individuals with FASD achieve positive outcomes if their needs and challenges are addressed early on in life and they have access to supports that carry into adulthood. There

is no known safe amount of alcohol to drink during pregnancy. Experts recommend that the safest option is no alcohol at all. According to CanFASD, up to 60% of pregnancies are unplanned and many people do not know they are pregnant until several weeks along. For more information, visit www.canfasd.ca

Good Shepherd Atrium Registration

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (also known as "the Atrium") is a parish-based ministry at Holy Cross Parish. It is open to all children between the ages of 3 – 13, offering them a unique opportunity for faith development. This program, founded in Rome, is a soundly traditional method of allowing children to enter more fully into the mystery of God using the principles of Montessori education. The sessions provide presentations, materials and a sacred space where the children can grow in their personal relationship with God, as it is first proclaimed to them through Jesus, the Good Shepherd.
