September is Arthritis Awareness Month

Arthritis is a collection of conditions that affect joints and other tissues. Symptoms can range from mild to severe. Most people living with arthritis experience chronic pain, fatigue, restricted mobility, lowered mood and other symptoms that can combine to erode their quality of life. According to Arthritis Society Canada, 1 in 5 Canadians live with the pain of arthritis. Half of those affected are under the age of 65. Children can develop arthritis too! People with arthritis are more likely to experience anxiety, mood disorders, poor mental health, and difficulty sleeping, compared to those without arthritis. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recognizes 5 strategies to help manage arthritis and its symptoms: 1. Learn self-management skills; 2. Be physically active; 3. Talk to your doctor; 4.
