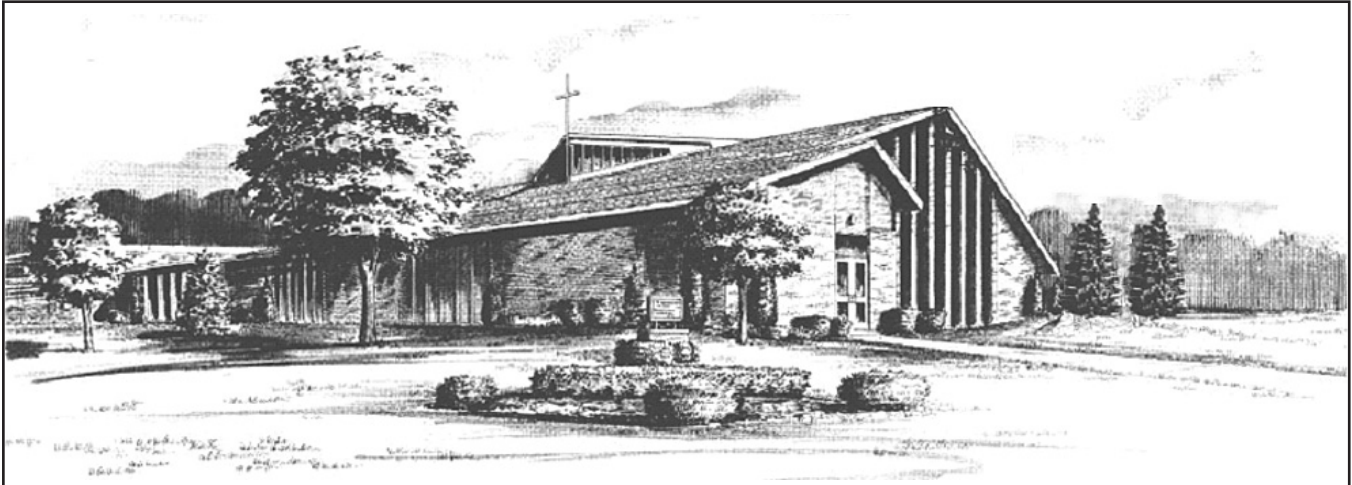

### Walk for Life - Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>

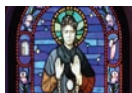
