Biblical Meditation How He is Made Known to Us

Finally, the delight that Jesus experiences in crowning the work of redemption by insituting the Eucharist is expressed by his actually distributing his Body and Blood among those he loves in order that he may from now on live in them permanently, in a reciprocal interpenetration of being: He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood lives in me and I live in him (Jn 6: 56). Nothing could be morer sublime, nothing more desirable, nothing more perfectly corresponding to the nature and longing of love....The Incarnate Word always keeps his promises because he both can and wants to do so. In him, power and love are one, and for this reason his greatest joy and delight is a union of identity whereby everything that he is and has can be enjoyed by his disciples as well. It is not surprising then that in the section on Jesus the True Vine in the farewell speech at the Last Supper, the Lord declared: I have told you this so that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete (Jn 15:11).

It was for this precisely that Christ came among us. The act of imparting his own eternal life to us by means of his Eucharistic self-bestowal is the royal work whereby he glorifies the Father: As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me (Jn 6:57).Just as selfcommunication among the Three persons is the communal joy of the Blessed Trinity, so too is it Jesus' own joy to make that life of dynamically circulating love available to as many as accept it. There is nothing, nothing at all, that Jesus possesses from the Father and the Spirit that he does not want us to share with him. Such a statement is saying a great deal, indeed, about a person who is God! And so at the Last Supper, just before his death, Jesus prays to the Father: But now I am coming to you and while still in the world I say these things to share my joy with them to the full (Jn 17:13). Jesus' joy in sharing his life with us in the consecrated Bread and Wine corresponds to the Father's joy in uttering the Word through whom and for whom were created all things in heaven and on earth (Col 1:16). And Christ's own joy, divine though it is, is not fulfilled until it flows into the bloodstream of our humble human existence.
