LOCAL HOSPITALS AND EMERGENCY PASTORAL VISITATION

If you or someone in your family is in the Oshawa, Whitby or Port Perry Hospitals and would like to have a priest (for serious reasons) visit the person who is sick for Anointing of the Sick, Last Rites, Confession or Communion, please note that there is a full-time Catholic Priest assigned to these three hospitals at various times of the week. Simply ask hospital staff to inquire as to whether *Hospital Chaplain* is present in the hospital (or when he will be). If the Hospital Chaplain is not available and there is an emergency requiring a Catholic priest, please call St. Leo the Great Parish at 905-655-3286 and when prompted, press "8" and leave your message. Fr. Mounir will receive your message (if he is available) and return your call. If there is no emergency but you would like to speak to Fr. Last week's (summary of the) reflection:

In some ancient traditions, certain tribes have a superstition such as devouring the heart of their enemy warriors. They do this in admiration and in order to acquire their courage, their skills, and their strength.

In many ancient religions also, it was the people who offered human sacrifices for their God. Only one religion, it is the Catholic faith where God dies for his people, and He offers himself as food for them (in the Eucharist). It is a distinct feature in our faith and it shows the dignity placed upon the human person and the greatness of our God.

An example I use with school children about the necessity of receiving the Holy Eucharist. I tell them, take for example how we fuel our cars. Cars use gasoline, aeroplanes must use another type of fluid in order to fly. There is also another type of fuel for space shuttles to fly in space.

God gives himself as food for our souls in order to be able to live the life of grace now and to rise to eternal life. This is not found in eating earthly food, but available only in the reception of the Eucharist.

Brothers and sisters: We are transformed spiritually by the divine life given to us. The Lord's state of being, becomes our possession. The Eucharist helps us live a life that will breathe peace, live in love, & exude joy.

The Eucharist strengthens us, cures our brokenness, our infirmities & our spiritual illnesses. Jesus in the Eucharist strengthens all the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us. The Eucharist is a foreshadowing of our future transfiguration and glory! (Check the Catechism of the Catholic Church for further reading on the Eucharist). Amen.

This week we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a dogma set by the Church and its ancient faith. All believers in the Catholic Church have an obligation to accept this teaching (and do their best to understand it).
