If Father Victor is not available and there is an emergency requiring a Catholic priest, please call St. Leo the Great Parish at 905-655-3286 and when prompted, press "8" and leave your message. Fr. Charles will receive your message (if he is available) and return your call. If there is no emergency but you would like to speak to Fr. Charles, please call the parish office and leave a message with the parish secretary at 905-655-3286 x 101.

CROWNING of the BLESSED MOTHER

May is traditionally the month of Mary and October is the month of the Rosary. When I attended elementary school at St. John the Evangelist in Whitby many moons ago I remember so well the May school celebrations of the crowning of Mary, the Mother of God. It was always festive with nice weather, streamers, flowers, all the children singing and a procession around the school with a statue of Mary. The pinnacle of our annual festival in honour of the Blessed Mother was a crown being placed on her head and our singing *O Mary We Crown You With Blossoms Today*.

I was taken back to my long-ago school days and the crowning of Mary with a recent invitation I received from the Rosary Apostolate of our parish to attend the May celebration they were putting on with the staff and students of St. Pope John Paul II school. Apparently there had been an earlier gathering in the school gym with the lower grades and the 10 am. presentation I was invited to was for the older half of the school. As the event began the children entering the gym did so with each student carrying a single rose to later be presented to Mary.

The Rosary Apostolate leaders introduced the spiritual event recalling how Mary was made the Mother of God by God's power and that when Jesus died on the Cross He gave His Mother, Mary, to John – which is to say that she was given to all of us who are disciples of the Lord Jesus.



Then the curtain was pulled back on the stage that was set for a beautifully rehearsed play that followed with a cast of students who filled the various roles in the life of St. Bernadette Soubirous who received the continuous apparitions of the Blessed Mother in Lourdes, France from February 1 to July 4, 1858. The play recalled the story of the poor Soubirous family who lived in

a part of an old jail and the family's challenge to put food on the

table. Bernadette herself was asthmatic and of frail health and one day, while going with her sister and cousin to gather fire wood, had encountered a beautiful lady she would eventually come to know as the Mother of Jesus coming to visit her. She entered a convent and became a nun with the Sisters of Charity of Never. She died on April 16, 1879.



Her body was later exhumed twice, as part of the usual canonization process, and was found to be perfectly preserved and miraculously intact (incorrupt) and is placed in a crystal casket where she can be viewed to this day in the Motherhouse

chapel of the Sisters of Charity, Nevers, France.

The children were all led in the praying of the Rosary with individual students announcing the mystery and another student leading in the Our Father and the subsequent 10 Hail Mary's. As each mystery was introduced and with each Our Father and Hail Mary beautiful slides were presented on a large screen so that each Mystery and each prayer that followed offered an image to better meditate and focus ones attention.

There were beautiful songs sung throughout and recorded music as well to better set the tone of prayer as Mary was honoured.

Following the Rosary, each child processed with their rose and placed it in front of the statue of Mary, framed by an impressive grotto made by one of our parishioners.

I was glad to have been asked to attend and to be able to participate in such a well-organized and devout



spiritual exercise to honour Jesus' Mother. The work that the children had put into this event was truly remarkable and their devout prayer sincere. The Rosary Apostolate of our parish had clearly put lots of time, preparation and love into this time of prayer and honour for the Blessed Mother even beyond their regular task of visiting all of our elementary schools and teaching children about the Rosary and how to pray it. All involved; teachers, staff, students, parents and the Rosary Apostolate are to be recognized and appreciated for the due honour shown to Mary, the Mother of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.



A bit of a miracle took place just prior to the event. I had arrived and was talking to a woman near the stage area when suddenly a heard a noise and gasps all around me. Apparently, the light-weight grotto tipped forward and knocked to the ground the plaster statue of Our Lady. The leaders rushed to the scene, expecting to find a shattered image of Mary but to everyone's amazement there was not a mark on it. God takes care of all of the details, doesn't He? (Fr. Charles)
