LOCAL HOSPITALS AND EMERGENCY PASTORAL VISITATION

If you or someone in your family is in the Oshawa, Whitby or Port Perry Hospitals and would like to have a priest (for serious reasons) visit the person who is sick for Anointing of the Sick, Last Rites, Confession or Communion, please note that there is a full-time Catholic Priest assigned to these three hospitals at various times of the week. Simply ask hospital staff to inquire as to whether *Father Pius Alejo* is present in the hospital (or when he will be). If Father Pius Alejo is not available and there is an emergency requiring a Catholic priest, please call St. Leo the Great Parish at 905-655-3286 and when prompted, press "8" and leave your message. Fr. Charles will receive your message (if he is available) and return your call. If there is no emergency but you would like to speak to Fr. Charles, please call the parish office and leave a message with the parish secretary at 905-655-3286 x 101.

PARISH CELEBRATES TEN YEARS IN OUR NEW CHURCH

Our parish church of St. Leo the Great was blessed 10-years-ago in April of this year. While the parish is now 31 years old, having been founded in 1985, the new church was opened in April of 2006 by then Archbishop of Toronto, Thomas Collins.

He expressed his regret that he would not be able to attend our special Mass and reception but related many facts about the parish that I didn't know. Among them was the news that while the parish was completed in 2016 he and so many of our parishioners along with representatives from the Archdiocese had begun the planning work *six years prior*. This underscores for me, and others I am sure, how so many of our parishioners, many who have since moved away or have gone to Glory, worked tirelessly for the spacious worship space and hall we now have and enjoy. All the more reason to celebrate who we are as a parish and where we've come from as Brooklin believers in Jesus Christ.

Lighthouse Media CD's in our vestibule

For several years now our parish has featured a Catholic Lighthouse Media kiosk in the vestibule, now unfortunately hidden from view near the Welcome Table. *Catholic Lighthouse Media* presents the "Giants" among Catholic speakers from the past and present who address a wide range of topics from the Sacraments, The Blessed Mother, Conversion, Sin, Mercy, Hope, Marriage, Raising Catholic Children, Youth, to finding help in living in today's world with today's problems. I invite you to check out the wall-mounted kiosk in the south-east corner of the vestibule. The cost of each single CD is just \$5.00 and there is a slot where you can deposit your money. For a long period of time, parishioner Francesco Bianco used to write up a review in the bulletin on one of the many featured CD's which served to help our parishioners in knowing a bit about a particular CD.

The CD titles and topics are constantly being replaced at the kiosk so it is always a good idea to check it out from week to week, as many of our parishioners do. These Cd's are great for listening at home or in your car as you travel. Check 'em out.
