Gospel Reflection:

We have two Gospels today — the triumphal entry into Jerusalem with the crowds waving their palm branches for Jesus following a short time later by the agonizing last hours of his life. There is a paradox that confronts the world in what we celebrate today — what looks like Christ's defeat in his crucifixion is actually his crowning moment of glory. The Cross for Christians is not a scandal but the positive proof of both Christ's love for you, me and the world. It is the means through which he breaks sin and death's hold over humanity. Today's Mass is the recounting of God's plan for our redemption nearing its climax — and how the cosmos is saved through God's love for us demonstrated in the most stark, real way possible in the Passion of his Son.
