#### **Gospel reflection:**

The Sunday after Easter Sunday is now known as Divine Mercy Sunday. The Gospel recounts an appearance of Christ to his followers after his resurrection. He miraculously appears to the Apostles (minus Thomas in his first appearance) later the same day after his resurrection. After his resurrection, Jesus is changed. He is no longer bound by normal laws of nature and can appear wherever he wants to be despite any obstacles he might encounter like locked doors or fearful followers. Nothing can prevent Christ drawing near to us except our refusal to welcome him. There is no sin, no flaw, no personal struggle than prevent the mercy of Gods, made manifest in Jesus his Son, reaching us except our choice to turn from him.

Explanation of the Image of the Divine Mercy: "The Heart of Christ! His 'Sacred Heart' has given men everything: redemption, salvation, sanctification. St. Faustina Kowalska saw coming from this heart that was overflowing with generous love, two rays of light which illuminated the world. 'The two rays,' according to what Jesus himself told her, 'represent the blood and the water' (Diary, p. 132). The blood recalls the sacrifice of Golgotha and the mystery of the Eucharist; the water, according to the rich symbolism of the Evangelist John, makes us think of Baptism and the gift of the Holy Spirit (John 3: 5; 4: 14). Through the mystery of this wounded heart, the restorative tide of God's merciful love continues to spread over the men and women of our time. Here alone can those who long for true and lasting happiness find its secret." (St John Paul II, Divine Mercy Sunday Homily, 2001)
