Gospel Reflection: The Gospel today presents Jesus's warning to his followers that the gospel will divide even the closest relationships. Jesus alludes to his impending death on the Cross when he speaks about his pending baptism and he speaks words of challenge and not comfort to his listeners. If following our faith alienates us from others, perhaps even family or close friends, we must not lose hope. Jesus warned us that discipleship would not be easy: being his friend is not going to get you into the 'cool kids club' – in fact it's almost a guarantee to exclude you from that clique. But you will be part of a heroic crowd of martyrs, saints, faith-filled ordinary folks and an intimate companion of our Lord and the Blessed Mother. It's hard to imagine wanting to fit-in somewhere else, isn't it?

The evening will include a talk by Teresa Kargul entitled "Listen to God: Do What He Tells You", praise and worship music, silent prayer time, confessions, and fellowship afterwards. Honouring Women Saints - St. Phoebe: the Church recognizes saintly people from all ages, cultures, backgrounds and both women and men. The pinnacle of human sanctity is the Blessed Mother Mary: she was Jesus's first and best disciple, our heavenly mother, model, guide and intercessor. Many of Christ's first followers were women who supported him, the apostles and Christ's mission and some were among his close friends, like Mary, Martha and Mary Magdalene (the first person to see the resurrected Jesus who was instructed to testify to her encounter to the apostles). On September 3rd, we may recognize Saint Phoebe, mentioned in St. Paul's Letter to the Romans (Romans 16:1-2). She held a responsible position in the early Church in Cenchreae, supported the missionary work of St. Paul and was entrusted by him to deliver his letter to the Romans, seeking support for his missionary work. commendation to the Romans, he describes St. Phoebe with the word "diakonos" in Greek, which has different meanings related to service, such as servant or "deacon", as well as a patroness or helper (in Greek "prostasis), a singular distinction for her as the only woman mentioned this way in the New Testament. The Synod, instituted by Pope Francis, ended its first phase with an announcement to continue the discernment of ordained women deacons in the Catholic Church. The modern word we use for a deacon is not synonymous with the original term, hence the need for further study and discernment. We honour St. Phoebe and her important leadership responsibilities in the early Church which show us that discipleship and responsibility are a common call to all the faithful! God calls us all to holiness: it is not a privilege for a few 'holy' women or men. Holiness, living our life in a God centered way, is for all of us. May St. Phoebe aid us in her prayers. Fr. Geoff

Synod Update: Pope Francis inspired our Church to try to learn and live Synodality, to learn to walk beside each other, on a common path, to listen well to each other in peace, at circular tables always listening to the Holy Spirit. Pope Leo is guiding our Church to keep walking together in Synodailty as our way of being Church. The Jubilee of Synodal Teams and Participatory Bodies will take place Oct 24-26, 2025 at the Vatican.
