The feast today is not about celebrating the perfect family. Instead it's about recognizing how God comes to us amidst the challenges and blessings of family life. It is significant that God values the human family so much that he wanted his son to have this experience so that he might truly be one of us in every significant way. Pope Francis reflected in 2014: "in the family life of Mary and Joseph, God is truly at the centre, and He is so in the Person of Jesus. This is why the Family of Nazareth is holy. Why? Because it is centred on Jesus. When parents and children together breathe in this climate of faith, they have an energy that allows them to face even difficult trials, as the experience of the Holy Family shows, for example, in the dramatic event of their flight to Egypt: a difficult ordeal." Mary Mother of God: Why do we celebrate this Solemnity? At one point in the Church's history this Feast was controversial. How could Mary, a finite human being, give birth to God who is infinite? The solution to this problem is apparent when we look at what happened at Christmas: as the mother of Jesus Christ, who is the second person of the Holy Trinity, Mary was indeed the Mother of God. This realization was an important moment because in affirming Mary as the Mother of God, the Church was teaching us that Jesus was "consubstantial" with the Father in his divinity and "consubstantial" with us in his humanity. We use this word "consubstantial" in the Creed to affirm our belief that Jesus is "of the same substance as" God and of humanity. Jesus truly is God and Jesus is also really human. So – Jesus did enter into our experience, to share with us all the challenges, struggles, pains, sufferings and joys of human existence, except sin. Because he was able to share our humanity with us, Christ was able to redeem us on the Cross. And because he was divine, his "yes" to God's plan which he assented to out of love for us on the Cross, could bring the saving grace of redemption to all who were open to receiving it. The title Mary Mother of God, it turns out, is significant for our salvation. Jesus needs to be both human and divine to deliver us from sin and death. Plus, Mary is also our spiritual Mother to whom we can turn in our need, knowing she will intercede for us on our behalf with her Son, Jesus. Can you imagine a better person to have praying for us than Mary?
