Reflection:

Jesus' baptism is not the same as the sacrament of baptism we typically celebrate with our infant children. The Church understands this non-sacramental baptism of Jesus by John in several ways: for example "perhaps [Jesus] comes to sanctify his baptizer; certainly he comes to bury sinful humanity in the waters. He comes to sanctify the Jordan for our sake and in readiness for us; he who is spirit and flesh comes to begin a new creation through the Spirit and water." (Gregory of Nazianzus). Fr. Geoff
