When Jesus tells his disciples do not fear, he is not talking about ordinary fears but rather the persecution that will come from being a Christian. More Christians have been killed for their faith in the last century and the first two decades of this one than in the preceding nineteen hundred years. Jesus encourages us in the face of persecution. People up to no good like to hide their misdeeds. But, Jesus tells us, nothing is hidden that will not ultimately be revealed. No-one will really 'get away' with anything. It may look like evil temporarily has the upper hand, but Jesus, by the Cross, has defeated the forces of sin and death.

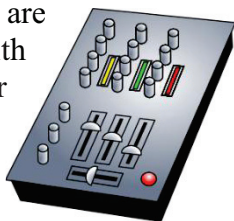
